

Make One for MS - Midlothian

Official Rules & Regulations

Event Date: August 29, 2026

Location: acac Midlothian, Richmond, VA

The Make One for MS fundraiser ("Event") is a charitable basketball shooting event benefiting the National Multiple Sclerosis Society. By registering and participating, each participant agrees to abide by the following Official Rules and Regulations.

1. Eligibility

- The Event is open to the public.
- Participants under the age of 18 must have a parent or legal guardian complete the registration and liability waiver.
- **ACAC team members ACAC team members (employees and event organizers), are not eligible to win prizes.** They are welcome to participate in support of the fundraiser but will not be eligible for raffle prizes or grand prizes.
- Event organizers reserve the right to verify participant eligibility before awarding any prize.
- Each participant may win a maximum of one prize package during the event. Once selected as a winner, that participant will be removed from all subsequent prize drawings.
- Must be present to win.

2. Registration & Entry

Participants may choose one of the following entry options:

\$10 Entry

- One (1) Free Throw Attempt

\$20 Entry

- One (1) Free Throw Attempt
- One (1) Half-Court Shot Attempt

Each paid registration includes only the shot attempts associated with that entry level.

All entry fees are charitable donations and are **non-refundable**.

3. Shot Attempts

- Free throws must be taken from the designated free throw line.
- Half-court shots must be taken from the designated half-court line.
- Participants must remain behind the designated line until the ball has been released.
- Any shot in which the participant steps over the line prior to releasing the ball will be ruled unsuccessful.
- Event officials will determine whether each shot is successful.
- All decisions regarding shot attempts are final.
- If a ball becomes stuck/lodged it will be treated as a dead ball and shooter will get one more attempt
- If a shot is materially disrupted by circumstances outside the participant's control, the event official may award a replacement attempt. All officiating decisions are final.
- Event organizers may provide different basketball sizes based on participant age.

4. Prize Eligibility

Participation Prize Drawing

Every registered participant will receive one entry into the Participation Prize Drawing.

Free Throw Prize Drawing

Participants who successfully make their free throw will receive one entry into the Free Throw Winners Prize Drawing.

Half-Court Grand Prize

Participants who successfully make their half-court shot will become eligible for the Half-Court Grand Prize Drawing.

If more than one participant successfully makes a half-court shot, the Grand Prize winner will be selected by random drawing from all successful half-court shooters.

If no participant makes the half-court shot, the Champion's group (\$20 ticket holders) will move to the 3-point line until one (or more) participants makes a shot

5. Prize Conditions

- Prizes have no cash value unless specifically stated.
- Prizes are non-transferable unless otherwise approved by the event organizers.
- No substitutions will be made except at the discretion of the event organizers.
- Winners are responsible for any applicable federal, state, or local taxes.

VCU Season Tickets

The VCU Season Tickets awarded as a prize are subject to the following conditions:

- The season tickets are **non-transferable**.
- The season tickets **may not be sold, auctioned, assigned, gifted, or otherwise transferred** to another individual or organization.
- Any attempt to sell or transfer the tickets may result in forfeiture of the prize.
- Should the advertised season tickets become unavailable for any reason, the event organizers reserve the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

Tax Reporting Requirement

The winner of the grand prize is solely responsible for any applicable federal, state, and local taxes associated with acceptance of the prize. Prior to receiving the prize, the winner must complete and return an IRS Form W-9, as required by law. If the winner fails or refuses to provide a completed W-9 or any other required tax documentation within the timeframe specified by the sponsor, the sponsor reserves the right to withhold or forfeit the prize and select an alternate winner, where permitted by law.

The sponsor may issue an IRS Form 1099-MISC (or other applicable tax form) to the winner for the fair market value of the prize, as required by applicable tax laws.

6. Event Conduct

Participants are expected to:

- Follow all instructions provided by event staff and volunteers.
- Treat fellow participants, volunteers, and spectators respectfully.
- Wear appropriate athletic footwear.
- Conduct themselves in a safe and sportsmanlike manner.

Event organizers reserve the right to remove any participant whose behavior is unsafe, disruptive, or inconsistent with the spirit of the Event.

7. Photography & Media Release

By participating in the Event, participants grant ACAC, Make One for MS, the National Multiple Sclerosis Society, and affiliated event partners permission to photograph, videotape, and use their name, image, voice, and likeness for promotional, marketing, fundraising, and social media purposes without additional compensation.

8. Weather & Event Changes

The Event will be held rain or shine unless weather or other conditions make participation unsafe.

Event organizers reserve the right to:

- Delay the Event
- Modify Event procedures
- Change the schedule
- Substitute prizes of equal or greater value
- Cancel the Event if circumstances beyond their control require it

9. Assumption of Risk & Liability

Participation in this Event is voluntary and involves inherent risks associated with athletic activities.

By participating, each participant acknowledges these risks and agrees to release, waive, and hold harmless ACAC, Make One for MS, the National Multiple Sclerosis Society, sponsors, volunteers, donors, event officials, and affiliated organizations from any claims, injuries, damages, losses, or liabilities arising from participation in the Event, except where prohibited by law.

10. Right to Disqualify

Event organizers reserve the right to disqualify any participant who:

- Violates these Official Rules.
- Provides false registration information.
- Attempts to cheat or circumvent the rules.
- Engages in fraudulent, unsportsmanlike, or disruptive conduct.

- Interferes with the fair administration of the Event.

Disqualified participants will forfeit eligibility for prizes.

11. Final Decisions

All interpretations of these Official Rules and all decisions made by the event organizers regarding eligibility, shot attempts, prize awards, and Event administration are final and binding.
